

Description of journey from K (Kentucky) to P - The End of Earth

A diagram of Our Hollow Earth and William Morgan's journey in the cavern starting in Kentucky to the chasm where they jump off and oscillate back and forth and come to rest at the Central Sphere of Gravity they called the End of Earth

Have you ever wondered what it is like within the shell of the Earth?

It's not full of molten lava like they teach you in school. In places the temperature does get quite high, but in most places it is quite cool, in the high 50's.

One person, that was taken to Our Hollow Earth through a cavern that begins in Kentucky, was William Morgan. In the early 1800's, William joined the Free Masons with the intent of divulging their secret rites, which he did. For doing this dastardly deed of publishing the Mason's secret rites, they had him

thrown into debtor's prison for a small debt he owed, then they kidnapped him out of the prison, and took him into the woods for a period of time. They then took a body of a person that had died that looked like him and threw the body into a lake, then pulled it out to tell everyone what had happened to William Morgan. The body was brought to his wife, Lucinda Pendleton, and she declared that yes, that was her husband.

But it wasn't. The Masons had taken William Morgan to a cabin out in the woods until his hair had grown long. They then came and put some chemicals on his hair that turned it white, and some chemicals on his skin to make it look wrinkly like an old man, and a chemical that turned his voice into that of an old man. Then they took him back to his wife, but he was unable to convince her as hard as he tried that he was her husband. She thought he was a tramp and told him to get lost.

The masons knew this would happen, and they planned to send William on a journey to Our Hollow Earth. Rejected by his wife, he resigned himself to the fate the Mason's had given him for divulging their secret rites to the world. He was taken to Kentucky, east of where the Cumberland River makes a bend near Smithland, to a small spring that empties into a small cavern. There an Inner Earth Guide was waiting to take him on the next leg of his journey. Years later, William Morgan returned and gave a manuscript to a friend to publish relating his journey to Our Hollow Earth. It was later published by John Uri Lloyd as, ETIDORPHA, which you can read on my friend's website at Etidorhpa (etidorhpacontent.blogspot.com).

In his book, William Morgan called himself, I-Am-The-Man. It was hollow earth researcher, Bruce Walton from Springville, Utah, that determined that I-Am-The-Man in ETIDORPHA was in actuality, William Morgan. William Morgan describes in great detail what it is like within the Earth's shell, from it's outer surface to it's inner surface, which his Inner Earth Guide told him was 800 miles thick. I have determined the Earth's shell is about two miles thinner at the equator than at the poles because the acceleration of gravity decreases from the poles to the equator. Of interest also, the Inner Earth Guide explained to William Morgan the beginnings of Our Hollow Earth. He said that the foundation of the Earth is a spiritual bubble upon which space dust and rocks accumulated until it had the thickness of 800 miles that it has today.

From William Morgan we learn that caverns get larger as you descend into the Earth, and are very dark until you reach a depth of about 10 miles where a phosphorescent glow allows you to see where you are walking. At a depth of 150 miles beneath the outer surface, they reached a large lake that was 6,000 miles

long. There they boarded a small boat that was powered by anti-gravity to cross the lake. At one point in crossing the lake, the Inner Earth Guide showed William the beginnings of a volcano that erupts periodically in Italy. It happens when water seeping down into the lake causes it to overflow and the water gushing out of the lake reaches a deposit of original space elements such as, phosphorus, potassium, magnesium, sodium and sulfur, that react spontaneously with fire in the presence of water and air, which is what causes lava to form and the water then turns into steam and pushes the lava out onto the surface of the planet as a volcano.

After passing the lake, they continued to descend further into the Earth. As they descended, gravity diminished until they could move with great bounds and ease. His guide explained that at that depth volcanism ceases because water tension is stronger than gravity and does not seep any deeper into the Earth. Soon they reached a cliff where they jumped into a great chasm that goes way past the center of gravity. After jumping off the cliff into the chasm, they fell past the center of gravity and then fell back towards the outer surface and oscillated back and forth until they came to rest at the center of gravity.

The Center of Gravity in the shell of the planet forms a sphere, located at a depth of 700 miles from the Outer Surface, and 100 miles from the Inner Surface of the planet. At this point, they used their minds to propel themselves over to one side of the chasm, where another Hollow Earth Guide was waiting to take William up and into the hollow of the earth to it's Inner Surface.
