What could be origin of the human race?

Evolutionists would say that we began as a microbe in some proverbial pond that evolved over millions of years into what we are today. But according to a Norwegian fisherman and his father, Olaf and Jens Jansen, the Lost Garden of Eden where the Bible says God placed our first ancestors Adam and Eve -- is in Our Hollow Earth.

It was on their last voyage together as fishermen that Jens Jansen and his son Olaf of 19 years, began their voyage to Our Hollow Earth from Stockholm, Sweden on April 3, 1929. Their voyage took them to the Lofoten Islands on the northwest coast of Norway where Jens was born and raised as a Norwegian fisherman. He later moved to Stockholm, Sweden where he married and had only one child, his son Olaf. On this voyage they crossed over to Spitzbergen from the Lofoten Islands and then headed to the northeast to the Franz Josef Islands. There, inspired by flowers and green grass on an inlet of the sea on the north coast of the Franz Josef Islands, they decided to follow a lead in the ice out over the Arctic Ocean towards the northeast in search of "The Chosen Ones" --cousins of their ancestors that migrated many hundreds of years previously into the "Land Beyond the North Wind."

Olaf and Jens did not know the Earth is hollow, nor that a Polar Opening existed as an entrance to that land. They were just fortunate that the lead in the ice took them through the North Polar Opening into Our Hollow Earth. Their small fishing

sloop with only a sail for power and a compass to guide them were their only assistance in sailing to that Land Beyond the Pole. The voyage through the North Polar Opening took them that whole summer, and by September they arrived at the Inner Continent. They sailed up a very large river they later learned was the River Hiddekel -- one of four rivers that flows out of the Garden of Eden. While going up the river they met a large pleasure ship of the hollow earth inhabitants and were invited aboard. The ship was powered by anti-gravity. It turned around and took them to their port city of Jehu where they were assigned to live with a teacher couple to help them learn their language of Sanskrit.

After a year learning their language, Olaf and Jens were taken overland aboard a monorail train powered by anti-gravity to their capital City of Eden located on the highest mountain plateau of the Inner Continent. They learned from the inhabitants of Our Hollow Earth that the City of Eden was built around the original Garden of Eden where God placed our first parents, Adam and Eve. I have determined that their capital City of Eden is located 800 miles beneath Independence, Missouri on the Inner Surface of Our Hollow Earth.

In his book, THE SMOKY GOD, which Olaf had published in Los Angeles, California in 1908 after returning from Our Hollow Earth, he describes the City and Garden,

"The City of 'Eden' is located in what seems to be a beautiful valley, yet, in fact, it is on the loftiest mountain plateau of the Inner Continent, several thousand feet higher than any portion of the surrounding country. It is the most beautiful place I have ever beheld in all my travels. In this elevated garden all manner of fruits, vines, shrubs, trees, and flowers grow in riotous profusion. In this garden four rivers have their source in a mighty artesian fountain. They divide and flow in four directions." (THE SMOKY GOD, pp. 113, 114)

Olaf describes this city as being built around a most beautiful garden in which,

"...all manner of fruits, vines, shrubs, trees, and flowers grow in riotous profusion. In this garden four rivers have their source in a mighty artesian fountain. They divide and flow in four directions. This place is called by the inhabitants, the 'navel of the earth' or the beginning, 'the cradle of the human race.' The names of the rivers are Euphrates, the Pison, the Gihon, and the Hiddekel." (THE SMOKY GOD, p. 114)

The four rivers that flow out of the Garden of Eden divide the Inner Continent into four areas. The River Pison flows towards their North Pole. The directions of the compass inside the earth are opposite ours. Their North Pole is our South Pole and their South Pole is our North Pole. The River Gihon flows towards their West, the River Euphrates flows towards their East. The River Hiddekel flows towards their South Pole, which is our North Pole. The directions of the compass inside the earth are opposite ours because the electromagnetic field lines caused by the shell of the Earth rotating about the Inner Sun flow inside the Earth towards their North Pole and out our South Pole, which then flows outside the Earth towards our North Pole and then back inside the earth in a continuous loop.

Gerardus Mercator, a famous European map maker published a map in 1569 showing the Inner Continent with the Garden of Eden on a high mountain plateau with four rivers flowing out of it to the four cardinal points of the compass. The map

was drawn from the best reports he could obtain from explorers. Not knowing how to depict a map of the interior of the Earth, he placed the map in the Arctic Ocean. The map accurately shows where the River Hiddekel empties into the North Polar Opening at 85 N 130 E, near Northland, Russia, where Olaf and Jens Jansen entered Our Hollow Earth in 1829 through a previously unknown giant hole in the earth.

The hollow earth inhabitants told Olaf Jensen that the Garden of Eden where their capital city is located is "the navel of the earth," where God placed our first parents Adam and Eve, around 5,000 B.C. From the Bible we learn that when Adam and Eve partook of the forbidden fruit, they were evicted from the Garden. In the Lost Books of the Bible, in the Book of Adam and Eve, it says that when God evicted Adam and Eve from the garden, they were told to go dwell in the Cave of Treasures, where they got lost. After wandering for many days trying to find their way out, the Book of Adam and Eve indicates that they emerged onto our surface world.

The sun that warmed them when they came out of the cave was not the same sun that gave them light in the Garden of Eden. Chapter XVI says that when Adam came out of the cave, he was afraid of the sun and its extraordinary heat because,

"Inasmuch as while he was in the garden and heard the voice of God and the sound He made in the garden, and feared Him, Adam never saw the brilliant light of the sun, neither did the flaming heat thereof touch his body."

The sun that warmed the Garden of Eden was the Inner Sun inside Our Hollow Earth, and is gentler than our hotter sun which warms the exterior of the planet.

From the scriptures, we learn that Our Hollow Earth is a living being, and that our first parents were literally "born" from the "womb" of our "mother earth." By emerging from a cavern after being evicted by God from the Garden of Eden in Our Hollow Earth for having disobeyed His command not to partake of the forbidden fruit, Adam and Eve were "born" into this, our outer world.

A passage in the Book of Moses confirms that the Earth is alive and that the origin of the human race began inside the Earth:

"And it came to pass that Enoch looked upon the earth; and HE HEARD A VOICE FROM THE BOWELS THEREOF, saying: Wo, wo is me, THE MOTHER OF MEN; I am pained, I am weary, because of the wickedness of my children. When shall I rest, and be cleansed from the filthiness which is GONE FORTH OUT OF ME? When will my Creator sanctify me, that I may rest, and righteousness for a season abide UPON MY FACE?" (Moses 7:48)

The good news from this eviction of Adam and Eve from the Garden of Eden to our surface world is that the human race came into being. It was by design. God gave Adam and Eve conflicting commandments in the Garden of Eden to preserve their free will. They were commanded to have children and "multiply and replenish the earth." Yet they could have no children until they partook of the forbidden fruit. When they decided to eat of the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, their bodies were changed from immortality to mortality, and they could now have children. But because they disobeyed God's command not to partake of the

forbidden fruit, they were then evicted from the Garden from His presence. The Garden of Eden was like a temple where God could come visit them on Earth. By disobeying God in partaking of the forbidden fruit, they could no longer live in the presence of God in the Garden of Eden, because no unclean thing can dwell in the presence of God. Their disobedience had made them "unclean."

After being evicted to our fallen surface world for having partaken of the forbidden fruit, God sent angels to teach Adam, Eve and their children His Gospel of Repentance and Faith on God's Only Begotten Son, Jesus Christ. Then by accepting the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ who would be born in the Meridian of Time, and who would pay for our sins (that we have repented of) in the Garden of Gethsemane where He sweat blood and the next day died for our sins on the cross of Calvary, He can then save us from Hell. Adam and Eve and their descendants (us) can then be cleansed of our sins through baptism and the reception of God's Holy Spirit, making it possible in the resurrection from the dead (which is a free gift of our Savior Jesus Christ), to return to live in the God's Holy presence.

So the origin of the human race is the Garden of Eden where God placed our first parents, Adam and Eve, and which garden Olaf and Jens Jansen found is located on the highest mountain plateau of the Inner Continent in Our Hollow Earth.
